Minimum Requirements:

- Ph.D. or Master in immunology, cancer biology, cell biology, biochemistry or related biological sciences.
- Basic knowledge on analytical method development. Previous hands-on experience on cell culture and bioactivity assays, such as cell proliferation assays, cell cytotoxicity assays, T-cell activation assay, ADCC, cytokine releases, etc is a plus.
- Ability to design, execute experiments independently and deliver the project milestones with high quality.
- Ability to master new techniques and adapt to new projects quickly.
- An efficient team player.
- A demonstrated record of trouble-shooting and problem-solving is a plus.
